Profuse apologies - please note below the corrections to the first printing of the book



General Note: Please don't forget to read page 10 for knitting terms and abbreviations, noting in particular how to make the proper increases.

p. 10 / Pattern Abbreviations

'skp' = slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over

p. 54 / Skip

Crown

Switch to dpn

Rnd 1: ...**27 (30)** sts remain

Rnd 3: ...**18 (20)** sts remain

Rnd 5:**9 (10)** sts remain

p. 56 / Mari

Crown

It should read "Repeat rnds 1 and 2, until there are 11(12) sts before each m1" - delete "**each time adding a k st before each m1**"

p. 59 / Clara

Rise

(K1, *yo, k2tog* repeat **8x** (9x) more, k1) repeat 2x more - 60(66) sts

p. 68 Vera

Brim

delete 'bulky 0(0)'

p. 70 / Vita

Crown

After increasing to 48(54 sts) - *disregard separate instructions for Medium and Large (it was meant for second variation) and just skip to 'K 1 rnd'*

Rise: First Variation

Attach color B and K for 6 in/15cm

(delete: K for 4"/10cm...which preceded it)

p. 74 / Bobbi

Rise

Rnd 1: K.

Rnd 2: k0(2)tog, k around—72(77) sts remain.

Rnd 3: k0(3), k0(2)tog, k around—72(76) sts remain.

Rnd 4: *k3, MB,* repeat around.

Rnds 5 to 7: K.

Rnd 8: k2, *MB, k3 - repeat from * around, end MB, k1

Rnds 9 to 11: K.

Rnd 12: k1, *MB, k3 - repeat from * around, end MB, k2

Rnds 13 to 15: K.

Rnd 16: *MB, k3,* repeat around.

Rnds 17 to 19: K.

Rnd 20: repeat rnd 4

Rnds 21 to 23: K.

p 84 / Nessa

Crown

Repeat rnds 1 and 2, each time adding an additional k sts before each m1, until there are **4(5)** sts before each m1 - **36 (42)**

Disregard next set of instructions for Medium and Large and skip to -K 1 rnd

p. 87 / Damien

Repeat rnds 1 and 2, each time adding an an additional k sts before each m1, until there are 9(10) sts before each m1 - **66 (72) sts**

p. 88 / Violet Seed:

First Variation: Gauge: **12** sts = 4in/10 cm

p. 89 / Violet Seed

Crown: First Variation

After you get to 60 (66)sts and have completed 'k 1 rnd' - *disregard separate directions for Medium and Large* - go directly to Turn-of-Crown

Crown: Second Variation:

Repeat rnds 1 and 2, each time adding an additional k st before each m1 until there are 5 sts before each m1 - **42 sts total** - k 1 rnd

For Medium, skip to **Turn-of-Crown**;

For Large: *k6, m1, k13, m1* -repeat once more - **46 sts total**

Turn-of-Crown and Rise

With B:

K 1 rnd

P 5 rnds

With A: **K 5** rnds

With B:

K 1 rnd

P 5 rnds

With A: **K 5** rnds

With B:

K 1 rnd

P 5 rnds

pg. 104 / Ella

See *Pattern Abbreviations* above also; the term 'skp' is used without being listed in the list of abbreviations....skp = sl 1, k1, pss0 = "slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over" (congrats to those attempting the most difficult pattern in the book!)

p. 126 / Skye

Rise

Note: The next round ensures that the color changes occur at the back of the hat.

With color (A):

For 3 rnds: k(19, 21), p(28, 30), k to the end ...or k(19, 21)

k(19, 21), p3, **BO** the next (22, 24) sts by purling, (*at this point, you should have a p st on the right hand needle*), p2, k(19,21).

...you should be at the marker, midpoint of the remaining stitches:

remove marker, k to the last 3 sts, p3. - *this gets you to the end of the row, so now you will begin to work back and forth to create the lower flap*

Crown

total sts at end: 50 (56) sts

p. 137 / Clem

Crown

total sts : 66 (72) sts
